THE EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS WAS HELD AT 6:00 P.M. PRESENT WERE COMMISSIONER PHILLIP MARSHALL, COMMISSIONER TODD EWEN, COMMISSIONER RICK ROBERTS, ATTORNEY APRIL GELTMAKER, AND AUDITOR KYRA STEPHENSON. THE UNDERSIGNED CERTIFY THAT THE ONLY ITEMS DISCUSSED WERE I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(2)(B) INITIATION OF LITIGATION OR LITIGATION THAT IS EITHER PENDING OR HAS BEEN THREATENED SPECIFICALLY IN WRITING, I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1-(9)

THE MEETING WAS OPENED WITH THE PLEDGE TO THE FLAG BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS FOLLOWED BY A PRAYER LED BY COMMISSIONER EWEN.

COMMISSIONER ROBERTS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE CLAIMS, PAYROLL, AND MINUTES. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER EWEN. MOTION PASSED.

**CODERED SYSTEM**

EMA DIRECTOR DENI STEMPOWSKI PROVIDED INFORMATION ON A PUBLIC SAFETY ALERTING SYSTEM THAT WOULD ENABLE LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICIALS, THE ABILITY TO SEND OUT ALERTS TO RESIDENTS OF THE COUNTY TO NOTIFY THEM OF PUBLIC SAFETY CONCERNS SUCH AS TORNADOS, FLOODS, MISSING CHILDREN, BOIL WATER ADVISORIES ETC. THE CITY OF SALEM AND PEKIN ARE THE ONLY TOWN IN THE COUNTY WHO HAVE TORNADO SIRENS ALERTING RESIDENTS. THIS SYSTEM CAN NOTIFY EVERYONE IN THE COUNTY OR IT CAN ALERT RESIDENTS IN SPECIFIC AREAS VIA CELL PHONE NOTIFICATION. THE COST OF THE SYSTEM WOULD BE \$28,015.00 WITH A ONE-TIME SERVICE FEE OF \$750.00. THERE WILL BE AN ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION FEE OF \$6,353.03 FOR ONE YEAR OR \$5,603.03 FOR 5 YEARS. DIRECTOR STEMPOWSKI IS APPLYING FOR GRANTS TO HELP WITH THE COST OF THE SYSTEM. SHE HAS ALREADY RECEIVED \$3,140.00 FROM THE DUKE ENERGY FOUNDATION. SHE PLANS TO DO FUNDRAISERS AND GET DONATIONS TO FILL THE GAPS OF THE GRANTS. COMMISSIONER MARSHALL MADE A MOTION TO PROCEED FORWARD WITH IMPELMENTING CODERED. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS. MOTION PASSED. DIRECTOR STEMPOWSKI WILL BRING A CONTRACT BACK FOR SIGNATURES ONCE SHE HAS RECEIVED ALL THE MONEY TO PAY FOR THE SYSTEM.

**HEALTH INSURANCE ENROLLMENT**

HEALTH INSURANCE RENEWAL FOR EMPLOYEES WILL BE SEPTEMBER 1, 2024. ZACK RICHARDS WITH KNAPP MILLER BROWN HAS BEEN IN CONTACT WITH THE CURRENT

CARRIER ANTHEM AS WELL AS SEVERAL OTHER CARRIERS. THE COUNTY HAS FILED SEVERAL HEALTH CLAIMS BUT DOES NOT HAVE ANY CHRONIC HEALTH PROBLEM CLAIMS. HE WILL BE BACK AT THE AUGUST 6, 2024 MEETING WITH QUOTES.

**STRUCTURE POINT AGREEMENT**

THE COUNTY RECEIVED A GRANT TO UPDATE THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN. THE COMMISSIONERS AGREED TO HIRE STRUCTURE POINT AS THE CONSULTING FIRMS TO HELP IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PLAN. ATTORNEY GELTMAKER HAS REVIEWED THE CONTRACT WITH STRUCTURE POINT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$57,400.00. COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGREEMENT WITH STRUCTURE POINT. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS. MOTION PASSED.
