

## COMMISSIONERS SPECIAL MEETING

JUNE 17, 2024



THE COMMISSIONERS HELD A SPECIAL MEETING TO DISCUSS THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN. COMMISSIONER PHILLIP MARSHALL CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER. THE PLEDGE TO THE FLAG WAS LED BY COMMISSIONER MARSHALL FOLLOWED BY A PRAYER BY COMMISSIONER. THOSE IN ATTENDANCE WERE COMMISSIONER PHILLIP MARSHALL, COMMISSIONER TODD EWEN, AUDITOR KYRA STEPHENSON, ANGIE BUCHANAN, KEELEY STINGEL, MARK ABBOTT, AND SHERRY FLEENOR.

AT THE JUNE 4, 2024 COMMISSIONER MEETING, THE COMMISSIONERS VOTED TO APPROVE STRUCTURE POINT AND HOOSIER PLANNING TO PUT TOGETHER THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE COUNTY. MATTHEW ROARK FROM STRUCTURE POINT ATTENDED THE MEETING. HE GAVE AN OVERVIEW OF WHAT THEY WOULD DO TO HELP COMPILE INFORMATION TO HELP PUT THE PLAN TOGETHER. THEY WILL LOOK FOR COMMUNITY INSIGHT, PHYSICAL LANDSIGHTS, AND EXPLORE GROWING EXISTING ASSETS THE COUNTY ALREADY HAS. THEY WOULD LIKE TO MEET WITH ALL THREE OF THE COUNTY SCHOOLS TO RECEIVE INPUT ON WHAT CAN BE DONE TO BETTER THE SCHOOLS AND THE COMMUNITIES THEY SERVE. THEY ARE ALSO LOOKING AT SETTING UP AT DIFFERENT FESTIVALS TO GET INPUT FROM THE CITIZENS OF THE COUNTY. HOOSIER PLANNING WILL BE WORKING THE PLANNING COMMISSION ON FINALIZING SOME OF THEIR ZONING PLANS.

THE EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS WAS HELD AT 8:00 A.M. PRESENT WERE COMMISSIONER PHILLIP MARSHALL, COMMISSIONER TODD EWEN, COMMISSIONER RICK ROBERTS, ATTORNEY APRIL GELTMAKER, AND AUDITOR KYRA STEPHENSON. THE UNDERSIGNED CERTIFY THAT THE ONLY ITEMS DISCUSSED WERE I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(2)(B) INITIATION OF LITIGATION OR LITIGATION THAT IS EITHER PENDING OR HAS BEEN THREATENED SPECIIFCALLY IN WRITING, I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1-(9)

THE MEETING WAS OPENED WITH THE PLEDGE TO THE FLAG BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS FOLLOWED BY A PRAYER LED BY COMMISSIONER EWEN.

COMMISSIONER EWEN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE CLAIMS, PAYROLL, AND MINUTES. THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER ROBERTS. MOTION PASSED.

**HEALTH DEPARTMENT - BOARD APPOINTMENTS**

MAGGIE ENGLAND DISCUSSED THE CHANGES FOR HEALTH DEPARTMENT BOARD APPOINTS. INDIANA CODE 16-20-2.4(B)(3) STATES ONE PERSON APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE FROM A LIST OF THREE RECOMMENDATIONS BY THE EXECUTIVE OF THE MOST POPULOUS MUNICIPALITY IN THE COUNTY. THERE ARE TWO BOARD MEMBERS THAT WILL NEED TO BE REPLACED OR RE-APPOINTED AT THE END OF THE YEAR. THE HEALTH BOARD WILL SEND IN THEIR RECOMMENDATIONS BEFORE DECEMBER.
