STRUCTUREPOINT REVIEWED THE DEMOGRAPHICS AND STATISTICS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY WHICH INCLUDED: 2020 CENSUS INFORMATION, 2024 HOME VALUES, HOUSEHOLD HOME OWNERSHIP STATS, HOUSEHOLD INCOME, COUNTY JOBS, UNEMPLOYMENT RATES, 2022 COMMUTER BEHAVIOR, TOURISM DATA, AND LAND USE.


