THE EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS WAS HELD AT 8:00 A.M. PRESENT WERE COMMISSIONER PHILLIP MARSHALL, COMMISSIONER TODD EWEN, COMMISSIONER TONY CARDWELL, ATTORNEY APRIL GELTMAKER, AND AUDITOR KYRA STEPHENSON. THE UNDERSIGNED CERTIFY THAT THE ONLY ITEMS DISCUSSED WERE I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(2)(B) INITIATION OF LITIGATION OR LITIGATION THAT IS EITHER PENDING OR HAS BEEN THREATENED SPECIFICALLY IN WRITING.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY COMMISSIONER MARSHALL.

CARDWELL LED THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. COMMISSIONER EWEN GAVE THE PRAYER.

CARDWELL MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER EWEN. MOTION PASSED.

CARDWELL MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE CLAIMS AND PAYROLL. COMMISSIONER MARSHALL STATED THE CLAIM FOR MURPHY ELEVATOR THAT WAS TABLED AT THE LAST MEETING WAS IN FACT DUE TO PAY. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER EWEN. MOTION PASSED.

- **HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT PROJECT UPDATE**
PAUL ECKERT REPORTED DRYWALL HAS BEEN INSTALLED AND PRIMER HAS BEEN APPLIED TO THE DRYWALL AT THE OFFICE SIGHT. THE BRICK WILL BE ARRIVING AND MASON WORK IS SET TO BE STARTED THE WEEK OF JUNE 9, 2025. THE ROOF IS SET TO FINISHED AS WELL. MR ECKERT IS SUPPOSED TO MEET WITH MIDWEST GAS TO DETERMINE THE ROUTING OF THE GAS LINES. DUKE ENERGY IS TO DO THE FINAL POWER SOON. THE FOUNDATION FOR THE SALT AND AGGREGATE BINS HAS STARTED. GRABER IS COMING TO DO FINAL MEASUREMENTS FOR MATERIALS FOR THE MECHANICS GARAGE AND SALT BUILDING. THE SEPTIC SYSTEM SHOULD BE APPROVED BY THE END OF THE WEEK.

PROVIDED A SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT TO SETTLE THE LAWSUIT OVER THE TOWN OF HARDINSBURG. BOTH PARTIES HAVE ACCEPTED THE AGREEMENT AS WRITTEN WHICH WOULD REPEAL ORDINANCES 2022-8, 2022-10, 2022-11. THE COUNTY WILL GIVE ALL PROPERTY AND FUNDS BACK. THE ORDINANCES WILL BE NULL AND VOID AND THE TOWN WILL GO BACK TO THE WAY IT WAS. THEY WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR SETTING UP A BOARD UNTIL THE NEXT ELECTION WHERE INDIVIDUALS WILL BE REQUIRED TO BE ON THE BALLOT. ATTORNEY GELTMAKER PROVIDED THE ORDINANCE RESCINDING THE ORDINANCE LISTED ABOVE. THIS WILL SERVE AS THE FIRST READING AND THE COMMISSIONERS WILL MOVE ON RESCINDING THE ORDINANCES AT THE JUNE 17, 2025 MEETING. CARDWELL MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER MARSHALL. MOTION PASSED 2-1 WITH COMMISSIONER EWEN OPPOSING.
