THE EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS WAS HELD AT 8:00 A.M. PRESENT WERE COMMISSIONER PHILLIP MARSHALL, COMMISSIONER TONY CARDWELL, ATTORNEY APRIL GELTMAKER, AND AUDITOR KYRA STEPHENSON. COMMISSIONER EWEN WAS ABSENT. THE UNDERSIGNED CERTIFY THAT THE ONLY ITEMS DISCUSSED WERE I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(9) TO DISCUSS EMPLOYMENT MATTER OF INDIVIDUAL EMPLOYEES, I.C. 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(2)(B) INITIATION OF LITIGATION OR LITIGATION THAT IS EITHER PENDING OR HAS BEEN THREATENED SPECIFICALLY IN WRITING.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY COMMISSIONER MARSHALL. THOSE IN ATTENDANCE WERE COMMISSIONER MARSHALL, COMMISSIONER CARDWELL, ATTORNEY APRIL GELTMAKER, AUDITOR KYRA STEPHENSON. COMMISSIONER EWEN WAS ABSENT.

#### PUBLIC COMMENT

- **LUCY BRENTON - COUNTY ISSUES**  
MS BRENTON SPOKE ABOUT RANDY LEE'S JOB BEING ELIMINATED BY THE FAIR BOARD. SHE SPOKE ABOUT THE PLAN COMMISSION'S POSTING OF MEETINGS.
- **DARRELL MCGUFFEY - ROAD WORK/REPERCUSSIONS ON BUSINESS RESULTING FROM ROAD WORK**  
MR MCGUFFEY STATED HIS BUSINESS, SMOKIN HOGS ON SOUTH MAIN STREET HAD SUFFERED DURING THE BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION THAT WAS DONE LAST MONTH. HE WOULD LIKE SOME TYPE OF COMPENSATION. HE STATED THE CONSTRUCTION TEAM BLOCKED HIS ENTRANCE OFF OF MAIN ST. HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT RICK VOYLES STATED HAVING THE STOP LIGHTS AT EACH END OF THE BRIDGE DURING THE CONSTRUCTION WAS THE BEST ALTERNATIVE

TO KEEP ACCESS TO ALL OF THE BUSINESSES IN THAT AREA OF CONSTRUCTION. HE PROVIDED A MAP THAT SHOWS A SECOND ENTRANCE TO SMOKIN HOGS OFF OF OLD 160. COMMISSIONER MARSHALL WILL LOOK INTO THIS FURTHER.

- **MISTY SULLIVAN – RANDY LEE'S JOB**

MS SULLIVAN STATED RANDY LEE HAS BEEN THE GROUNDSKEEPER AT THE FAIRGROUNDS FOR 15 YEARS AND HAS MANY DUTIES. SHE FEELS RANDY PUTS IN A LOT OF HOURS THAT HE IS NOT GETTING RECOGNIZED FOR AND WOULD LIKE THE COMMISSIONERS TO KEEP HIM AS THE GROUNDSKEEPER.


- **HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT**


COMMUNITY CROSSINGS IS ABOUT THREE-FOURTHS DONE.
