

## COMMISSIONER MEETING

THE EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS WAS HELD AT 8:00 A.M. PRESENT WERE COMMISSIONER TODD EWEN, COMMISSIONER TONY CARDWELL, ATTORNEY APRIL GELTMAKER, AND AUDITOR KYRA STEPHENSON. COMMISSIONER MARSHALL WAS ABSENT. 
- **HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT PROJECT UPDATE**
