
THE SIGN SHED HAS ENCLOSED AND THEY WILL BE SPRAYING ON THE FOAM INSULATION AND STARTING THE ELECTRIC AND PLUMBING. TRUCK LEAN TO HAS THE METAL WORK DONE AND IS READY FOR ELECTRIC. THE FUEL SHED IS ENCLOSED. THE MECHANICS GARAGE IS WAITING TO BE APPROVED BY THE STATE. THERE WAS A VERTICAL CODE THAT INVOLVED AN ISSUE WITH THE FIRE WALL. THEY ARE WORKING WITH THE STATE TO GET IT APPROVED. THE MIXED SALT BUILDING WILL BE NEXT TO BE CONSTRUCTED. THEY WILL BE GETTING THE REBAR THIS WEEK FOR THE FOUNDATION. ONCE THE STATE ISSUES THE PERMIT FOR THIS THEY WILL START CONSTRUCTION. THE STATE HAS CLEARED THE BRUSH ALONG THE BYPASS. JACKSON COUNTY REMC HAS STARTED THEIR WORK ON GETTING FIBER TO THE LOCATION. THE TIMELINE FOR COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT IS FALL 2025.
